

#### EREN HOLDING, SHOTTON MILL


SEC Newgate successfully delivered the high-profile launch of Eren Holding's £600m redevelopment of Shotton Mill - the largest single foreign investment into Wales. We mobilised a dedicated team to manage stakeholder engagement, ministerial protocols, media relations and all event logistics.

Working closely with both the UK and Welsh Governments, we ensured aligned messaging and a seamless on-site experience for over 200 attendees, including two UK Secretaries of State and two Welsh Cabinet Secretaries.

Our Studio team designed a new website in the lead up to the launch, delivered stunning drone videography and photography of the construction site and developed and produced an impactful launch video, which was played to guests during the event.


### NatPower

#### NATPOWER UK, YNNI CELYN & CEGIN ENERGY

In North Wales, we led the community and stakeholder engagement for NatPower and Brockwell Energy's renewable developments – specifically the Ynni Celyn and Cegin Energy BESS projects. We ran bilingual, community-focused engagement across planning stages, including in-person events and digital consultation tools. We tailored our approach to Welsh policy frameworks and planning sensitivities, ensuring inclusive, locally relevant engagement that met policy and procedural needs.

#### METLEN, OPEN-CYLE GAS TURBINES IN HIRWAUN

SEC Newgate support METLEN Energy & Metals, a multinational industrial and energy company headquartered in Greece, who are currently building four open-cycle gas turbines (OCGT) power plants in the UK, one of which is in Hirwaun, near Aberdare.

Following planning approval, we supported METLEN in understanding the specific requirements, challenges and local constraints facing the individual sites as they moved into the construction phase. We also provided media, communications and stakeholder support for each of the projects.

This included targeted stakeholder engagement to support the delivery of the Abnormal Indivisible Loads (AlLs), which for Hirwaun was a complex and multi-phased programme. We successfully delivered an extensive programme of communications and co-ordination, requiring liaison with emergency services, local authorities, traffic agencies, government bodies and other key stakeholders, including thousands of local residents and the travelling public.
